PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Fellow Auxilians:

"Plus ça change, plus c'est la même chose."

At the Hubbard House, we've had occasion to move our records from one office to another; while doing this, I couldn't resist reading 40-year old Auxiliary minutes (in bound ledgers, penned in a classic hand). My observations fell into two themes:

One: We have changed. I learned the year we added a Fall Antiques Show to our yearly Spring show (1974), and that we are now netting from each show almost ten times what we did then (!), while utilizing three times as many volunteers. I saw how the Gift Tree Shop grew in space and merchandise so that the annual contribution to the Auxiliary increased by five times.

Two: We are still the same. We continue to respond to requests from the hospital community in the same spirit and with the same detail and energy we did then. We were growing plants and donating them to the landscaping; we now support a landscaper and have put in vegetable gardens (come to the courtyard and pick!) We raised enough money to establish two patient libraries, buy furniture, and made gifts for babies born in our nursery; now we are poised to make a major contribution to the hospital's renovation.

Those of us who volunteer on site will continue to provide invaluable personal assistance to patients and their families, to make their experiences at APD both caring and comfortable, and lift small burdens from hospital staff so they can devote more of their energy to our shared goals.

This is an invitation for you to join us in the fall, when we begin a new round of interesting speakers and meetings. Be assured that our spring programs will be dedicated to topics of interest to this community. I look forward to seeing you as we come together to socialize, share our expertise, and enjoy a pleasant and invigorating discussion!
